

Girls Softball - 2008 Rules for Jr. Pigtail Division

Any/All situations not covered in these rules will be governed by the official ASA rules of softball.

1. All games will be played on the date and time indicated on the official schedule. There will be a 10-minute grace period for the 6:00pm starting games. These 10 minutes do and will count as part of the 70-minute game time.
 - a. Jr. Pigtail plays on Mondays and Wednesdays
 - b. First game has a start time of 6:00pm
 - c. Second game has a start time of 7:15pm
2. Jr. Pigtail must field a minimum of 9 players and maximum of 12 players (5 outfielders). Rovers or Deep Second position are required to play behind the base path. When 12 players are used, there must be at least 5 outfielders. When 11 players are used there must be at least 4 outfielders.
3. If a team cannot field the minimum number of players the umpire will declare a forfeit.
4. Call-ups for the division directly below the playing team are not permitted.
5. Prior to the start of play, the Leagues Chief Umpire will be responsible for declaring whether conditions are suitable for playing a game or if the games should be postponed.
6. There will be one week set aside mid season and one week at the end of the season for the scheduling of make up games as needed. If there is not a need for make-up games, the last week of the season will move up to this week.
7. The league board members and division directors will schedule make up games.
8. Games in progress can be called due to weather conditions or darkness at the discretion of the umpire. Incomplete games are to be handled as any other cancelled games being replayed during the weeks set aside at mid season and end of season. Games will be replayed in their entirety.
9. Official complete games consist of:
 - a. Minimum of 4 innings (3 and ½ if the home team is winning)
 - b. No inning may start after 1 hour and 10 minutes has passed. Time limit supersedes the inning rule.
 - c. If after the end of 3 innings one team has a lead of 12 runs or greater the game will be considered complete.
 - d. In regular season, if the time limit has been reached and the game is tied, the game will be considered complete and each team will receive ½ a point for victory.
10. Players are required to wear their league provided numbered shirts.
11. Rubber soled athletic shoes or rubber cleats are to be worn. Metal spikes are not permitted. Socks are mandatory.
12. Any player on deck, at bat, on base paths, or in the coach's box must wear a helmet. Chin straps on helmets will be based on specific city specifications. Eastlake Girls Softball does require chin straps be worn.
13. All players in the field must be wearing a mitt.
14. Catchers must be wearing a face mask and chest protector.
15. Bats can be either slow pitch or fast pitch as long as they are ASA stamped. Metal bats only, wood bats are not permitted.

16. Unless a player is being benched for disciplinary reasons or injury, all players in attendance and in uniform must bat the entire game and play in the field for at least half the game. (3 of 6 innings, 2 of 4 innings). Everyone participates in the batting order and fielders must be rotated.
17. Opposing manager is to be notified prior to the start of a game of all players benched for disciplinary or injury reasons.
18. If a player is injured during the game, the opposing manager must be notified immediately. The injured players batting turn is skipped without any penalty or out assessed to the team.
19. If a player is injured while running the base paths, a courtesy runner is permitted. This runner must be the last batted out player.
20. Players injured and removed from a game are free to return to the game in their previous line-up position when able.
21. For safety, no player will be permitted to play while wearing a cast or hard brace. "Ace" bandages or neoprene braces are permitted.
22. Managers must exchange line-ups prior the start of a game and must inform each other of changes to the line-up during the game.
23. Home team is the official scorekeeper. To avoid disputes, the visit scorekeeper, should verify and agree on the score after each inning.
24. Home team will have the **first base** bench and is responsible for putting the bases away. Only players, coaches and scorekeepers are permitted in the bench area.
25. Pitching distance is 40 Feet (Revised 5/1/2007 to comply with ASA rules)
26. Base Path distance is 50 feet.
27. Sliding is permitted but not required.
28. Unlimited foul balls are permitted.
29. Ground rules are determined prior to the start of the game by the umpire.
30. Base on Balls/Walks
 - a. If a pitcher has thrown four non-strike balls.
31. Double Base will be used in both divisions. Whenever a play is being used on the
 - a. batter/runner, the **defense must use the white** base and **batter/runner must use the orange** base. If there is no play, the batter/runner may use either part of the base.
32. Time out will be called when the pitcher has control of the ball within a 10 foot radius of the pitching rubber or the opinion of the umpire that all play has ceased. If the base runner is halfway or more to the next base she will be awarded the base. If not, the runner will return to the previous base.
33. A 3-foot arc should be attempted but is not required in the Jr. Pigtail Division. A pitch will be called strike if the umpire believes the pitch could be hit. Fast pitch is prohibited.

Disciplinary Action:

In order to provide an environment that is safe and enjoyable to all Eastlake Girls Softball will not tolerate inappropriate behavior from its players, coaches or fans.

Players, coaches and fans can and will be asked to leave the premises if deemed necessary by the umpire.

Players may be suspended for up to 2 games for inappropriate and/or offensive behavior. The suspension must be enforced in the games immediately following the players notification by the Board of Directors that she has been suspended. The player must be in uniform and on the team bench in order for the suspension to count.
